

Dalton Airport Building Guidelines

- You must obtain board approval prior to construction start
 - Obtain Building Permit & Soil Erosion Permit
 - Member must file FAA Form 7460-1 Notice Of Proposed Construction.
Mail completed form to:
 - Federal Aviation Administration
 - Air Traffic Airspace Branch, AGL-520

 - Plan for an automobile parking area that allows parking that is well clear of taxiway and the wings of passing aircraft

- Follow hangar construction description in bylaws:
 - Pole barn construction
 - Lockable doors
 - Plans must be approved by board before being built
 - All hangars must be the same color

- You are financially responsible for any airport damage caused by your building activity
 - Delivery loads are limited to a maximum of 5-yards of concrete and a maximum of 7-yards of sand to prevent taxiway damage
 - Double-train trucks are not allowed on airport property
 - Make sure construction vehicles stay off of surface areas that can be damaged by their weight or movement while working
 - No construction vehicles allowed when frost laws are in effect

- You or your representative must be present for all deliveries
 - Ensure that delivery vehicles enter the airport at the correct location, travel directly to your site, and leave without driving thorough any areas unnecessarily
 - Make sure materials and construction equipment are placed far enough away from taxiways that they do not impose a hazard to aircraft or other vehicles
